Operationally deployed in the Afghanistan and Libya conflicts, Brimstone has proved to be the weapon of choice with its unique ability to perform both surgical strikes and salvo engagements in time critical missions with a true day/night capability.

Brimstone Sea Spear has been designed to be modular and can be integrated to a wide variety of vessel types/classes.

- The same missile can be used from fixed wing and naval platforms, minimising logistic support infrastructure.
- Brimstone Sea Spear is a modular, flexible system adaptable to a wide variety of existing ship system configurations
- The system is user friendly with mode selections via a touch screen control panel
- The system is fire and forget and in salvo operation can rapidly cope with both swarms of targets and individual target(s) situations
- Brimstone Sea Spear is automatic and enables quick salvo launch to allow multiple target engagement whilst maintaining adequate stand-off distance. It allows the firing vessel tactical freedom to manoeuvre away from the threat or to intercept other targets
- Salvos can be selected to counter the swarm density and target lead formation elements
- The system provides a rapid response, all weather, day and night capability
- The ship fit is adaptable from 2 to 12 munitions on the weather deck
